CAMP TIPTON



We are in full swing recruiting and planning for summer this year. If your church has youth or young adults that might want to work during the summer, **working at Camp Tipton is a great opportunity to share Christ with others and grow in spirit with other believers around the same age. We are helping develop young leaders in the church.** I would be glad to come talk to your youth or college groups about the opportunity they have to serve at Camp Tipton. The link for summer staff is <http://www.camptipton.com/summer-staff.html>. To be eligible to work on our team, we start allowing people to serve as a counselor in training at 15 years of age! At 16-18 and still in high school, we start our paid positions for junior counselors. **Our most needed position this year is junior counselors.** If you know of a sophomore-senior in high school that would love to serve the Lord this summer, have them follow the link above or reach out to Matt Fowler at camptipton@gmail.com

We are beginning to accept scholarship requests for summer camp for 2024. If you know of a family in need that may need help allowing their children to come experience a great Christ-focused summer camp, point them towards our direction! We are asking for prayer and donations for our scholarship fund this April. Each week of prayer, your churches Sunday school classes can focus on prayer for our ministry during the summer. This includes staff, mission teams, and campers that will be attending camp. Every donation towards camp will go straight towards putting children in our community into camp this summer.

If Christ compels you to donate, consider donating monthly. A week of day camp is \$180 this year so \$15 a month can support a child for a week of camp. A week of overnight camp is \$320 so \$27 a month will support a child for a week of overnight camp. My goal for this year is to give out \$35,000 in scholarships to allow around 50 children to be on scholarship this year.

We are also now taking registration for this year's summer camp.
